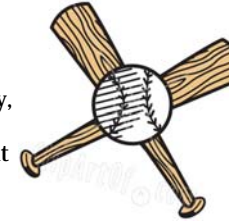
Retired teachers, Kathi Hanson and Gail Rennie, are traveling to Tanzania for three weeks to teach classes at the Akeri Medium School.
