focus of february outreach offering: the women's center

The Women's Center is an independent, non-profit human service agency serving the Waukesha area. Its mission is to provide safety, shelter, and support to women and their families and to facilitate their development. The Women's Center provides free and comprehensive services to address the issues of domestic violence, sexual assault and abuse.

St. John's has a long standing relationship of providing support to the Women's Center. To assist them with their mission, our monthly donations emphasis for February will focus on the following items: lotion, deodorant, facial tissues, toilet paper, paper towels, ZipLoc bags, food storage containers, baby monitors and size 5 & 6 Diapers.
