#### *Mission of Healing in El Salvador*

**Travel:** The team is in need of helpers who like to play with children and who might be interested in helping in a teaching area. Spanish is not a requirement. Contact the church office to get connected to trip applications, the Facebook group, and other resources. Application deadline is December 1. Cost is \$650 plus flight (probably about \$700). Trip dates are February 3-11, 2018.

**Give:** Your financial support will help the team purchase basic medications in El Salvador. Every family that participates in the Mission of Healing receives a basic first aid kit with Tylenol for children and for adults. The team also purchases anti-parasite medication for those who need it. Check to St. John's with memo: Mission of Healing.

**Give:** Band-Aids and Toothbrushes! Toothbrushes should be soft or extra-soft, for adults or children. Donations may be placed in the Shopping Cart! This is our FOCUS FOR NOVEMBER!

**Make:** Days for Girls Kits. These are washable feminine hygiene kits for girls and young women. They are given out during the Mission of Healing at a teaching center about menstruation. Contact the church office to get connected with St. John's women who are involved in this project! Donations of DARK patterned flannel are also welcomed!
