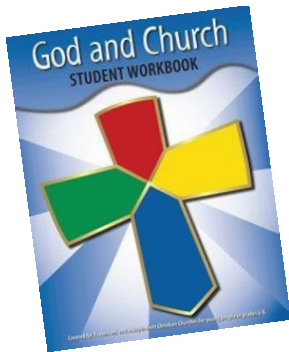


6th – 8th Grade Students

During January & February, all St. John's Sunday School students K-6th grade will be working through the P.R.A.Y. curriculum to help grow their understanding and faith in God and Christ. Students in 7th – 8th grade have the opportunity to participate and earn the God & Church award if they choose to. They would attend class instead of going to YLT on Sunday mornings.



God and Church Curriculum

Students in 6th-8th grade will go on a three-part faith journey: meeting Jesus, worshiping God, and witnessing and ministering for Christ. Young people will have the opportunity to work with their pastor or other adult as they study the church's structures and objectives and participate in service projects that will give them a better understanding of the mission of the church.


Students will meet on Sundays 1/6, 1/13, 1/20, 1/27, 2/3, and 2/10 from 9:45-10:35 in the Paul Room downstairs with Mrs. Lange and Mrs. Elfers. There will be work for students to complete outside of class as well.

There is a faith-based award associated with this program that any student can earn. Students who are Scouts have the opportunity to take this curriculum a step further and earn an award to wear on their uniforms. It will be presented to them during worship on

Scouting Sunday, February 24, 2019 at 8:30 or 10:45am.
