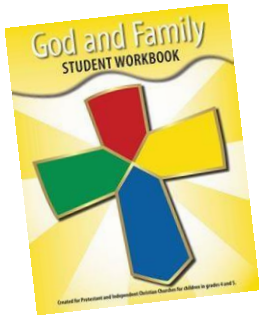


4th – 6th Grade Sunday School

The God and Family Program provides an opportunity for young people and their families to explore their faith together. Children will read about different families in the Bible, which can teach them about God's plan for strengthening families. To remember these lessons, children will compare families and "pizza." They will make a pizza as they study how families can grow together in God's love, and they will choose "family projects" to be done with their family at home.
