### newborn kit thanks and update

We are well on our way toward reaching our goal of 301 kits this year, but with only 9 weeks remaining, we still need many items!

Needed Items – minimum still needed to reach goal of 301 kits is listed after each item. Every item donated makes a difference in the life of a baby!

- small bath towels (48"-52") – 180 more needed
- receiving blankets (approx 30"x30") – 213 more needed
- washcloths – 0 more needed!
- baby Hats - newborn (about 14" circumference) – 0 more needed!
- baby shirts/onesies - newborn sizes – 184 more needed
- Ivory Bar Soap (bath size) – 112 more needed
- pre-folded cloth diapers – 2 diapers per kit – (funds needed to purchase in bulk)
- diaper pins – 2 pins per kit – 382 more needed
- 2 gallon ziplock bags – 65 more needed
- monetary donations are always needed and are used to purchase items which are not easily donated.
