We finish our calendar year with two holidays – Christmas and New Year's. They are so close together that many people take the week between them as a time away from work. It is a nice ending to the year.



We live in a new year with this amazing story, the story of Jesus Christ, who fills and fulfills our deepest hopes and redeems us in the glory of God.


Now that is something to celebrate all year long!

Pave the Way - Great News to Share



We have great news to share as we begin the new year and look forward to planning and paving the way for ministry in 2024 and beyond. With the Christmas weekend pledges, commitments to our Pave the Way campaign have reached \$287,386.55! We are just short of our \$300,000 goal by approximately \$13,000. More than half of the pledged funds have been received. This wonderfully generous response has positioned St. John's to move forward with reconstruction of the circle drive in 2024. As a reminder, the painting of the church building and striping of the parking lot are completed and paid off, and an initial tithe to the Hope Center was sent in December.

Heartfelt thanks to all who have included the Pave the Way campaign in your 2023 charitable giving and overall charitable planning into 2024. As we reflect on the beauty and joy of the Advent and Christmas Season at St. John's, we acknowledge God's presence among us and God's abundant blessings poured out on our congregation and its ministry. The Lord has indeed given us a Christmas to remember as we celebrate the greatest gift of all.

Altar Flowers






El Salvador Trip
