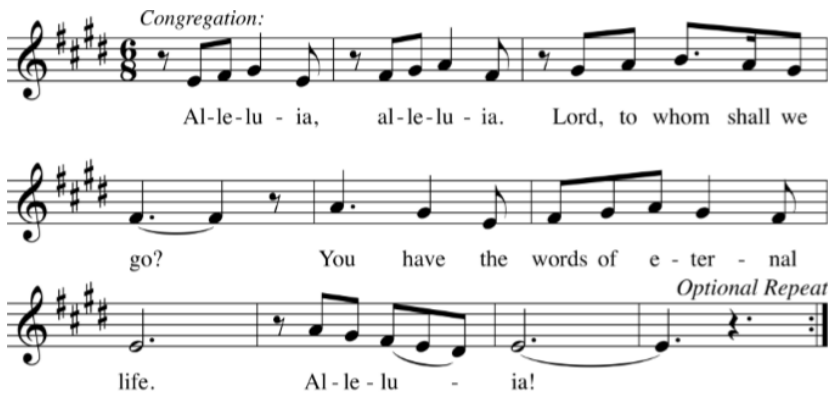

## APOSTLES' CREED

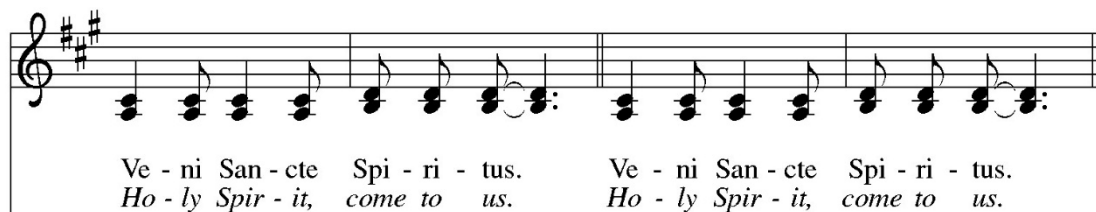
**I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.**
